Link2 uses culturally responsive motivational interviewing skills (open-ended questions, reflective listening, affirmations) to build authentic relationships with students.

Based on previous research, children who receive Link2 have increased connectedness to an adult at school and reduced symptoms of stress.

Through Link2, school personnel protect and nurture at-risk children by engaging in positive interactions with students to address psychological and developmental needs.
